Article 1

The participants decide during the race entry if Endurance Day vzw may publish imagery of the participant during the race. Participants can have access to the electronically saved data that was provided to the organisation.

Article 2

It's an open race track. This means that pedestrians and cyclists are allowed on the race track. All traffic that enters our race track will be informed that a race is taking place. The current race track is a guideline. There is no guarantee this will be the effective race track, but it's the race track we prefer for the race. Certain circumstances could mean we have to change the race track. This won't give right for a refund!

Article 3

Start and finish: Driegoten 97-95, 9220 Hamme

We start Saturday 23 November 2024 at 10h (6h) sharp.

We start Saturday 23 November 2024 at 13h (3h) sharp.

If you are too late, you may start depending on the given conditions. You have to take into account the additional time already passed.

Article 4

Accompaniment by bike is <u>not</u> allowed. All participants will receive a race number for the electronic and manual time registration. Showers are available from 16h15 till 17h30 at sporthal Meulenbroek, Kaaiplein 32, 9220 Hamme.

Article 5

Entries are completed after the payment of the entry fee. The payment will be done electronically. Day registrations are only possible at the secretary until 30 minutes before the start of the race or online until November 15, 2024. The secretary is located at the start zone. The address is Driegoten 97-95, 9220 Hamme. You can request additional information here and register for the race.

6h Ultra Challenge of Hamme solo

Pre-entry: 30 euro (possible from 10 December 2023 till 23 October 2024)

Online day entry: 35 euro (possible from 23 October 2024 till 16 November 2024)

Day entry: 40 euro

Runners who participate in 2 running races in the same year receive a total discount of 2.5 euro. Runners who participate in 3 running races in the same year receive a total discount of 7.5 euro.

Article 6

Participating in this race requires a good health. The organisation recommends to take a preventive sport medical examination. Each participant is also insured. Persons aged 15 years or younger can't subscribe for this race. Persons aged 18 years or younger can only enter the marathon or ultra race if they can provide a medical certificate. We recommend amateurs to enter a shorter race. If the organisation believes the participants are too young to enter a certain race, they will ask additional information. The organisation can't he beld responsible for injury, loss, theft and/or damage at material of participants, supporters and spectators. The organisation assumes participants agree.

We recommend the following maximal running distance per age:

12-13 years: 6,5 km14-15 years: 10 km16-17 years: 16 km

• 18-19 years: Half marathon

Article 7

Cancellations are only accepted when a medical certificate is provided before 15 November 2024. If you cancelled your entry, we will refund the total amount of your entry, unless you cancelled after the given date. You can also transfer your participation to another participant who didn't enter the race yet. In this case you won't need a medical certificate, unless the candidate is younger than 18 years. Transfers are only possible till 16 November 2024. We don't charge administration costs. If you do a transfer we ask to send us the data for both the endorser and the endorsed person. Transfers after 15 November 2024 are not possible. This doesn't, just as cancellations after the given date, give right to a refund.

Article 8

Participants that entered but didn't start will not be registered. You may take your own supplies with you. Supporters along the race track may also provide supplies for you. Please make sure you don't interrupt other participants while you take supplies! On the race track we also foresee sanitary as well as the necessary garbage collectors. We ask the participants to have the necessary respect for our nature, our environment and the private domains. Participants who don't follow the rules can be disqualified from the race. Participants who exit the race must return their race number at the next refreshment zone. Their laps are registered and will count for the final race result.

Article 9

The award ceremony will take place at Driegoten 95-97, 9220 Hamme, immediately after we have registered all remaining meters of the last lap. Each participant receives a digital certificate. In addition, they also receive a personalised medal and a goodie bag (while supplies last). For the top three men/ women (overall) there are souvenirs provided. In addition, we also provide a digital race result.

Article 10

In the event of a dispute, only the courts of the judicial district of East Flanders, division Dendermonde, are competent. In the event of a dispute, the Dutch version of the regulations is binding.
